## Introduction:

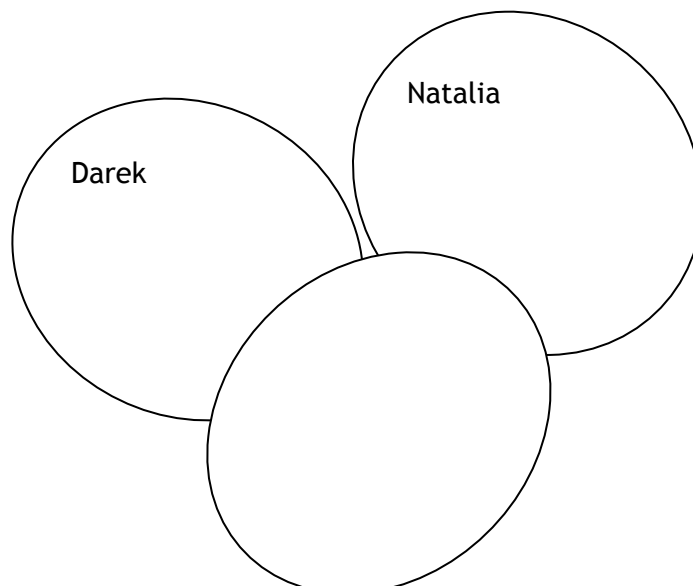
The teacher asks lead-in questions:

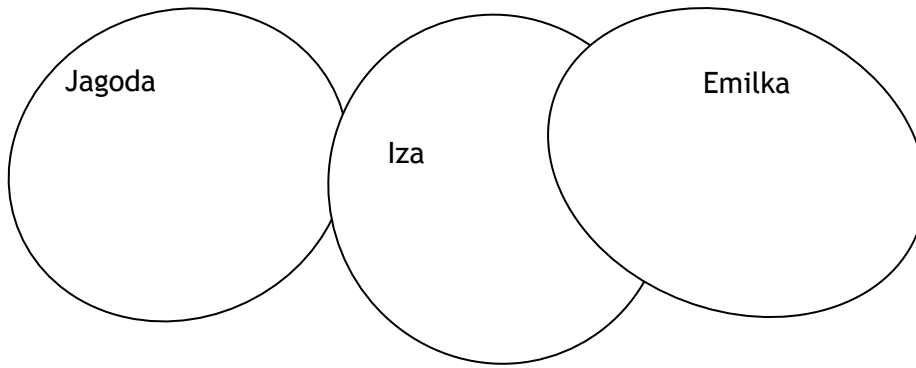
- What do you do in your free time?
- Do you read books? When?
- What kind of books do you like?
- What kind of books do you dislike, avoid?

## Task 1.

The teacher asks the group to talk about their hobbies, interests, book topics, authors for 5 minutes.

The students are asked to write down any similarities in their answers. They note down in the middle of the “flower” (the worksheet). Any differences they write down in the “petals”





### Task 2.

The teacher asks the students to go to the website: <http://lubimyczytac.pl/> They need to find out what is worth reading. The all group read the online-opinions and consider the books with the highest score.

Next they Check other blogs and read the opinions about the books there.
